

FORD'S COLONY DRESS CODE
(Updated February 2016)

It is expected that Members will dress in a fashion befitting the surroundings and atmosphere provided in the setting of the Club and will advise their guests accordingly. Management reserves the right to enforce and make changes to the dress code from time to time. Exceptions may be made for special events.

Appropriate Golf Attire

The following applies on the courses, practice range and putting greens.

- Proper golf attire is required at all times
 - No blue jeans or cut-offs
 - No tank tops, halter tops, bare midriff or spandex clothing
 - No camouflage clothing, cargo shorts/slacks not designed for golf
 - Collared shirts required for men
 - Tailored shorts, women's golf skorts or skirts should be an appropriate length (knee to mid-thigh)
- Soft spikes are required on the courses, range and putting green.

Ford's Colony Country Club offers multiple casual and more formal dining areas. The dress code for each is dictated by the nature of the dining venue or event being held there as outlined below.

Casual Dining Venues **(Murdoch's Tavern The Oasis Patio, and upstairs Terrace)**

Casual attire is permitted except for:

- Ripped, soiled, stained, frayed, cut off, or bare midriff garments
- Camouflage clothing

Acceptable denim apparel is permitted and defined as being well pressed, uniform in color and not frayed, patched or otherwise in disrepair.

Recognizing that casual attire includes designs modeled on athletic wear, such designer wear is allowed as long as it is a fashion befitting the atmosphere and setting of the Club.

Shoes or sandals are required.

The Colony Room **(Would include the main Dining Room when accommodating Colony Room dining spill over or special dining events)**

Country Club Casual – For men, this would be tailored slacks or khakis with dress or collared shirts or sweaters. While jackets are recommended in the evening, jacket and tie are not required except when specified for a more formal event.

Tattered or torn clothing, tank tops (dressy ladies' tank tops are allowed), halter tops, bare midriff, camouflage, workout attire are not permitted.

Appropriate golf attire (as defined above) is permitted. Gentlemen are requested to remove their hats.

Denim apparel is not permitted.

Shoes or sandals are required.

Special Event Dining Venues **(Banquet Room, Dining Room, Pavilion)**

Attire can range from appropriate golf attire to Country Club casual to formal depending on the event being held in the venue.

However, tattered or torn clothing, tank tops (dressy ladies' tank tops are allowed), halter tops, bare midriff, camouflage, workout attire or spandex clothing are not permitted in any case.

Denim apparel is not permitted unless specified for the event and then must be acceptable denim as defined above.
